Von 2002 bis Oktober 2008 war er als Brustchirurg bei der Stiftung “Fondazione Salvatore Maugeri“, Pavia, Italien (Dr. Alberto Costa) tätig. Seit November 2008 Vize Direktor des Brustzentrums des Cancer Centers Humanitas, Rozzano, Milano, Italien. Dr med. Wolfgang Gatzemeier graduated in 1987, in medicine from the University of Göttingen, Germany. From 1987 to 1991 he was study co-coordinator of the German Breast Cancer Study Group. He finished his training in general surgery at the Department of Surgery of Göttingen University, in 1998. During his training period, he was responsible for the outpatient clinic for surgical oncology, mainly focusing on breast cancer, as well as the interdisciplinary day hospital for systemic cancer treatment. From 1999 to 2001 he worked as research fellow at the Breast Unit of the European Institute of Oncology, Milan, Italy (Prof. Umberto Veronesi). From 2002- September 2008 he worked as a breast surgeon at the Breast Unit at the Maugeri Foundation, Pavia, Italy (Prof. Alberto Costa). From October 2008 until present he is vice director at the Breast Unit Humanitas Cancer Center Rozzano, Milan, Italy. His main fields of interest in clinical research are management of women at high risk for breast cancer, new imaging techniques for early detection of breast cancer, new developments in breast conservative surgery and new techniques in breast irradiation. He is active in promoting and supporting the process of developing European Breast Cancer Units since 2000 and was co-founder of Breast Centres Network in 2004. From 1999- 2015 he was the scientific coordinator of the European School of Oncology Masterclasses (ESO, Milan, Italy). From 2000-2004 he was a member of the Steering Committee of the "Leonardo da Vinci Project" of the Federation of European Cancer Societies (FECS), Brussels for the development of a European-wide system in Continuous Medical Education. From 2001-2014 he was a member of the Accreditation Council of Oncology (ACCOE /UEMS) in Europe, Brussels. He is member of the scientific committee of mamazone in Germany and Italy focussing on patient education (Diplomat patient). He is member of the editorial board of The Breast. From 2002-2006 he was member of the FECS education and training committee. He is coauthor of several chapters on breast cancer in text books of surgery and author of various articles in peer reviewed journals.
